PREVENTATIVE VASCULAR SCREENINGS

ANKLE-BRACHIAL INDEX (ABI) \$50

What is it? An ABI test helps evaluate peripheral arterial disease (PAD). It is performed using blood pressure cuffs on the arms and legs. It is important to screen for PAD because it increases the risk of coronary artery disease, heart attack, and stroke.

Who's at increased risk?

- Family history of cardiovascular disease or stroke
- Tobacco usage (past or present)
- High cholesterol
- Diabetes
- Obesity
- High blood pressure

CAROTID ARTERY SCAN \$50

What is it? Ultrasound of the carotid arteries in the neck, screens for buildup of plaque called atherosclerosis, which is one the leading causes of stroke.

Who's at increased risk?

- Age 55+
- Family history of cardiovascular disease, heart disease, or stroke
- Smoking (past or present)
- High Blood Pressure
- Diabetes
- High Cholesterol
- Obesity

Most people have little to no symptoms leading up to stroke, aneurysm, and peripheral arterial disease, which is why it's important to get screenings. If you are at increased risk or have known disease, yearly screenings are generally recommended. Call radiology M-F 8:00am-5:00pm 970-854-9729 with questions or to schedule an appointment.

Vascular screening identifies arterial plaque, indicating cardiovascular disease risk. Early detection aids in cholesterol management and prevents heart attacks and strokes. Preventative Vascular Screenings are available Monday - Thursday from 8am - 4pm and are cash pay due at time of service. These screenings are not billable through insurance. Results are mailed to you.

ABDOMINAL AORTIC ANEURYSM SCAN (AAA) \$50

What is it? Ultrasound of the abdominal aorta to screen for the presence of an enlargement or aneurysm. AAA can lead to a ruptured aortic artery, which is a life-threatening medical condition.

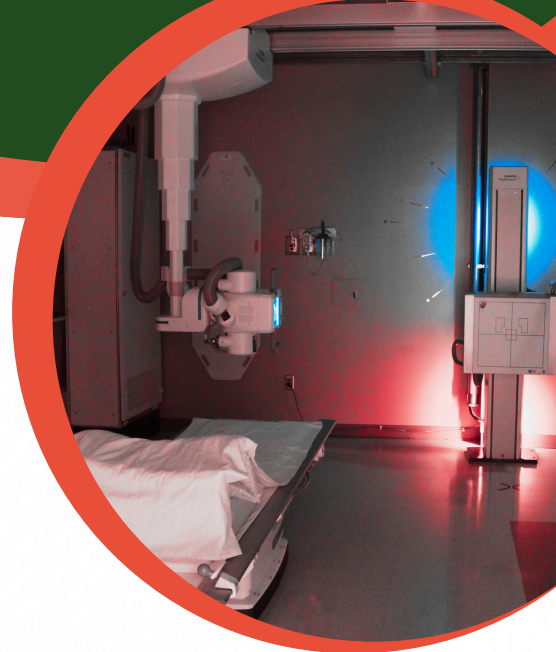
Who's at increased risk?
